

It allows to reduce the size of web pages and any other typical web files to about 30% or less of its original size before it transfer.



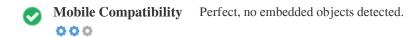


